

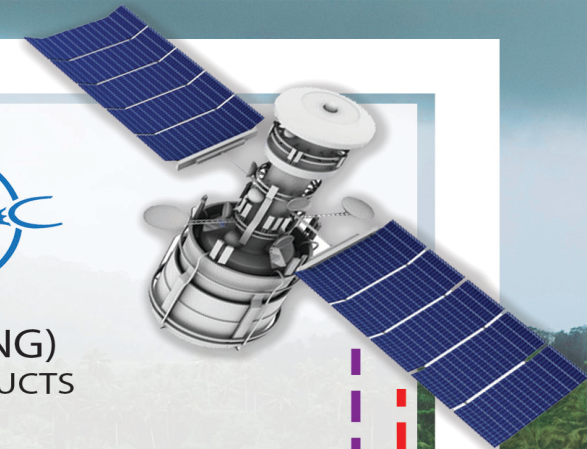

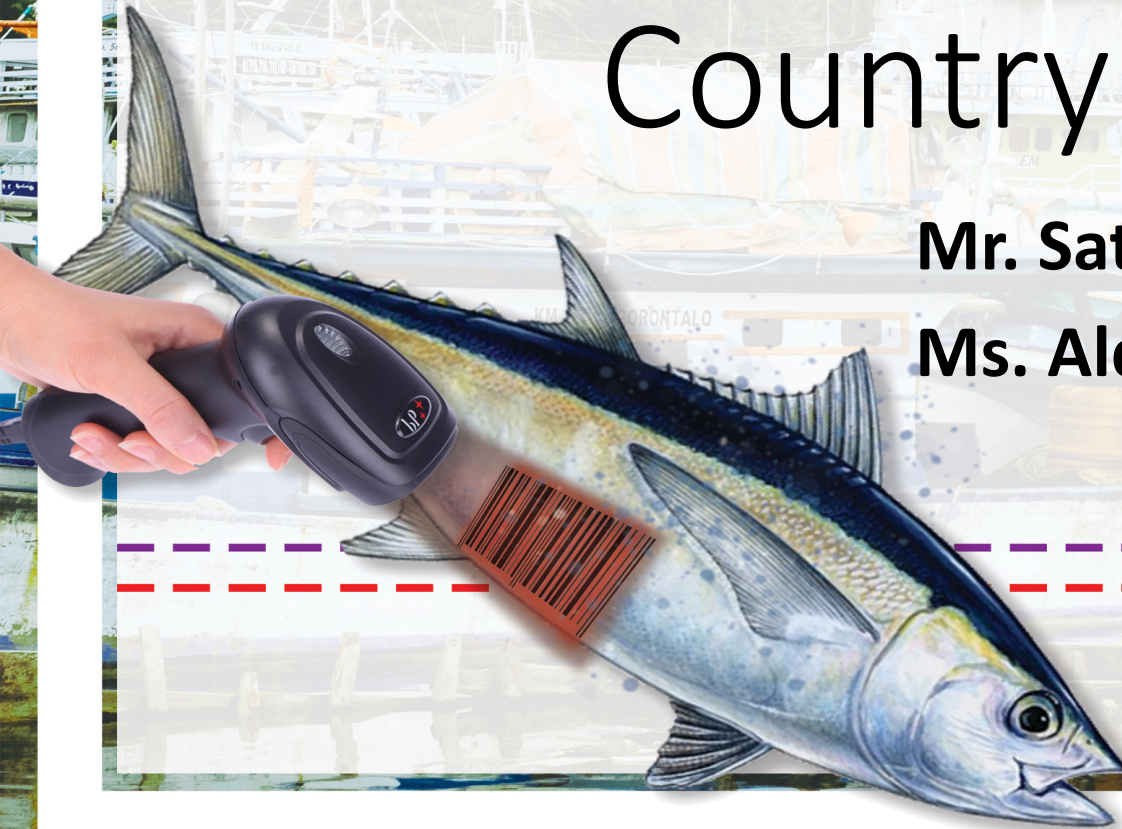

## II. FISHERIES SECTOR BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Republic Democratic of East Timor has a coastline of more than 730 square kilometers, on which are situated approximately 100 fisheries communities that have been using a wide range of fish and other marine products on sustainable basis for next generations. Most tropical fish species, including large pelagic, Tuna, Marline, Sharks, Small, pelagic, coral reef fish, demercal fish, and deep water fish are taken along with crabs, shellfish, shrimp, crustacean, seaweeds, coral reef and mangrove.
